



The Junior Teach-In is held on the leafy Loughborough University campus. Participants will stay in single, en suite rooms in one of the university's newest halls of residence. All meals are included in the entry fee. Local youngsters may attend at a reduced 'non-residential' rate.

Whilst the emphasis is on playing bridge, there is plenty of time in the schedule for socialising and other sporting activities, including the annual rounders match.

Accompanying adults are welcome, and there is a dedicated bridge programme for those 'non-youngsters' wishing to play.



The cost is £160 per student (£175 for adults), inclusive of all meals, two nights' en-suite accommodation, and all the bridge fun.
